Thank you for reaching out and sharing your concerns regarding the Wallace Drive southbound lane closure from Stelly's Cross Rd to Silverdale Pl.

We understand how frustrating it is to face ongoing detours, especially after much of the sewer project has been completed.

While the majority of the work is finished, the southbound lane remains closed as we finalize critical safety elements, including the installation of barriers, signs and lane markings.

The delay was primarily due to the Christmas break, during which construction activities were paused. Although there have been some rain-free days, completing certain tasks requires specific conditions and coordination to ensure the work meets required standards.

Please know that the remaining tasks are being prioritized to reopen the lane as soon as possible. If you have any further questions don't hesitate to contact us directly.
