Dear Mayor and Councillors,

I am writing to express my support to convert one tennis court into four pickleball courts at Centennial Park.

On the peninsula, there are already 15 purpose-built tennis courts and no dedicated pickleball courts (with permanent nets and lines and only used for pickleball). Pickleball play on the peninsula is growing every year and, unfortunately, there are very few places to play.

The current two temporary-shared courts at Centennial on Court #1 are booked and used daily. It would be nice to convert this extra tennis court into four purpose-built pickleball courts which would be hugely popular with the pickleball community. The work done would be minimal and the Victoria Regional Pickleball Association (which has now amalgamated with the Saanich Peninsula Pickleball Association), would finance this conversation into pickleball courts.

Please pass the motion to approve this project—pickleball players would be thrilled to know that Central Saanich supports pickleball on the Saanich Peninsula.
